PLANTING PHEASANTS

FOR EASY FIELD PLACEMENT: Tuck the pheasants head under its wing, place bird on its side (not the brisket) on the ground and stroke its breast firmly about 4 times. You will know the bird is asleep because it will be breathing deeply and will not move. The bird will stay this way for about 10 minutes and will not flush when it wakes up.

DID YOU KNOW: On flat ground, a ringneck pheasant can run at speeds of 8 to 10 miles per hour. Pheasants can fly at speeds up to 45 miles per hour.
